The District owns and operates stormwater management facilities, subdivision streets, street lights, wetland mitigation, and landscaping and irrigation throughout Sections 8, 9, 16, 17, 20 and 21, Township 27 South, Range 19 East. The community is currently fully developed with no additional demands necessary to these facilities.
