The Audience Comment portion of the agenda is where individuals may comment on matters that concern the District. Each individual is limited to three (3) minutes for such comment. The Board of Supervisors or Staff is not obligated to provide a response until sufficient time for research or action is warranted. IF THE COMMENT CONCERNS A MAINTENANCE RELATED ITEM, THE ITEM WILL NEED TO BE ADDRESSED BY THE DISTRICT MANAGER OUTSIDE THE CONTEXT OF THIS MEETING. The second section is called **Business Administration**. The Business Administration section contains items that require the review and approval of the District Board of Supervisors as a normal course of business. The third section is called Business Items. The business items section contains items for approval by the District Board of Supervisors that may require discussion, motion and votes on an item-by-item basis. The fourth section is called Staff Reports. This section allows the District Manager, Engineer, and Attorney to update the Board of Supervisors on any pending issues that are being researched for Board action. Occasionally, certain items for decision within this section are required by Florida Statute to be held as a Public Hearing. During the Public Hearing portion of the agenda item, each member of the public will be permitted to provide one comment on the issue, prior to the Board of Supervisors' discussion, motion and vote. Agendas can be reviewed by contacting the Manager's office at (813) 933-5571 at least seven days in advance of the scheduled meeting. Requests to place items on the agenda must be submitted in writing with an explanation to the District Manager at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date of the meeting. The final section is called Supervisor Requests. This is the section in which the Supervisors may request Staff to prepare certain items in an effort to meet residential needs.

Public workshops sessions may be advertised and held in an effort to provide informational services. These sessions allow staff or consultants to discuss a policy or business matter in a more informal manner and allow for lengthy presentations prior to scheduling the item for approval. Typically no motions or votes are made during these sessions.

THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of the Minutes of the Board of Supervisors' Regular Meeting held on October 28, 2014

On a Motion by Mr. Karpay, seconded by Mr. Noble, with all in favor, the Board approved the Minutes from the Board of Supervisors' Regular Meeting held on October 28, 2014 for Cordoba Ranch Community Development District.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of the Operation and Maintenance Expenditures for October 2014

On a Motion by Mr. Noble, seconded by Mr. Karpay, with all in favor, the Board approved the Operation and Maintenance Expenditures for October 2014 (\$35,150.83) for Cordoba Ranch Community Development District.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Resignation Letter from Rvan Huev

Mr. Roethke presented a resignation letter from Ryan Huey to the Board.

SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Presentation of Resolution 2015-01, Canvassing and Certifying Landowner Election Results

Mr. Roethke presented Resolution 2015-01, to the Board, canvassing and certifying the results of the Landowner Election.

Mr. Roethke administered oath to Ms. Jaxheimer-Mills. Mr. Roethke informed Ms. Jaxheimer-Mills she is eligible to receive \$200.00 per meeting as a Board supervisor, up to a maximum of \$4,800.00 per year. Ms. Jaxheimer-Mills declined compensation.

EIGHTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Presentation of Resolution 2015-02, Redesignating Officers

Mr. Roethke presented Resolution 2015-02, re-designating the officers of the Board. Mr. Karpay and Mr. Noble will stay on as Chair and Vice Chair, respectively, with Mr. Lovo, Ms. Jaxheimer-Mills, and Mr. Woodley being added as Assistant Secretaries.

On a Motion by Mr. Noble, seconded by Mr. Karpay, with all in favor, the Board adopted the Resolution 2015-02 for Cordoba Ranch Community Development District.

NINTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Pond Update

Mr. Roethke presented the pond inspection report to the Board. Mr. Beierle discussed the details of the pond report with the Board and updated them on the current status of the carp stocking proposal. A discussion ensued regarding the addition of grates that will need to be installed to the outflow structures as per a requirement from SWFWMD and the FWC. Mr. Beierle is still following up with the biologist and as soon as they are able to confirm the details of the carp stocking, Mr. Beierle will bring a proposal back to the Board.

TENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Proposal for Aerator Installation for Pond #146

Mr. Beierle distributed a proposal for fountain installation for pond #146. A discussion ensued. Mr. Karpay recommended not moving forward with this proposal at this time.

ELEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Landscaping Update

Mr. Roethke gave a brief landscape update to the Board. There was a lightning strike that damaged the front entry gate, as well as, some irrigation equipment and landscaping. The cost of the irrigation replacement is less than the insurance deductible, so a claim was not submitted at this time. If additional costs arise, then a claim can be submitted. The gate repairs have been completed and Envera repaired the damage to the security equipment.

A discussion ensued regarding several other maintenance items, including a dying palm at the entrance, issues with the Magnolia trees, and a sign from Cornerstone that needs to be removed near the District entrance. Mr. Roethke will follow up on these items.

TWELFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Ratification of ValleyCrest Proposals

Mr. Roethke presented several proposals from ValleyCrest that require Board ratification, including annual installation, hydro-seeding, trash removal, and palm fertilization.

On a Motion by Mr. Karpay, seconded by Mr. Noble, with all in favor, the Board ratified the proposals from ValleyCrest at a total cost of (\$3,260.00) for Cordoba Ranch Community Development District.

THIRTEENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Property Transfer from Cordoba Ranch CDD to Standard Pacific

Mr. Karpay updated the Board on a piece of land that was deeded to the CDD in error. This tract should have stayed under the ownership of Standard Pacific. The Surveyor is preparing a legal description to complete the transfer, and the recitals of a contract between Standard Pacific and an outdoor advertising company state that Standard Pacific owns the property. Mr. Karpay added some additional details regarding this issue.

On a Motion by Mr. Noble, seconded by Mr. Lovo, with all in favor, the Board ratified the transfer of property deed from the CDD to Standard Pacific, pending review of the legal description by District Counsel for Cordoba Ranch Community Development District.



The following report is for January to illustrate what has changed from December and what to expect through February and the coming months.

The photos this month were taken on Tuesday 01/13/2015.

Minor algae issues were present and have been addressed on Wednesday 01/14/15. Over all the ponds are looking very good with a few seeing some filamentous algae on the surface. At the end of the report, I have added a few photos and notes about other issues I've spotted around the property during my inspection along with a couple proposals. Over all the winter has been fairly mild this year, unfortunately, this often leads to heavy levels of plant & algae growth in February and March as water temperatures heat up. We are preparing for a very challenging spring burst of vegetative growth based on patterns we are observing now, not only in Cordoba but throughout most of the waterways we manage.

We have received the deposit for the 2 entrance fountains we were contracted to install and are coordinating with Mandy Electric on the project schedule. The equipment is built and already shipped here to our warehouse. Our production staff will be completing their annual training next week (week of January 19-23rd). Our tentative installation is the following week or 1st week of February. You can expect to see two new fountain displays in next months report!

The homeowners' association at the Palms of Cortez has had problems with erosion along their community lake for years. They contacted Dove Engineering and Consulting, LC to come up with a solution that would alleviate the issue, while still providing an aesthetically-pleasing look.

John Slupecki with Motz Enterprises was contacted by Dove Engineering for help with selecting a product. 



Fees and expenses will be invoiced upon completion or monthly, as applicable, and will be due and payable when invoiced.

The monthly fees outlined herein shall be amended annually as reflected in the adopted General Fund Budget of the District. Such new fees, as authorized by the District's action to adopt the General Fund Budget, shall become a binding schedule of this Contract until otherwise changed by a subsequent action of the District.

The one-time charges outlined herein shall be subject to change in the future upon request of the Client for additional services. Such revised one-time charges will be provided to the Client for approval prior to commencement of any additional services.

CLIENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Client shall furnish all required documents, data and information relative to the project necessary for the Consultant to perform the duties of this Contract. In addition, Client shall provide timely services of its staff deemed necessary as the project progresses. Expenses incurred in providing this support shall be the sole responsibility of the Client.

TERM:

This Contract may be terminated as follows:

- 1) By the Client for "good cause" which shall include misfeasance, malfeasance, nonfeasance or dereliction of duties by the Consultant. Termination for "good cause" shall be effected by provision of a minimum of 30 days written notice to Consultant at the address noted herein;
- 2) By the Consultant for "good cause", which shall include, but is not limited to, failure of the Client to timely pay Consultant for services rendered in accordance with the terms set forth in this Contract, malfeasance, nonfeasance or dereliction of duties by the Client, or upon request or demand by the Board, or any member thereof, for Consultant to undertake any action or implement a policy of the Client which Consultant deems unethical, unlawful or in contradiction of any applicable federal, state or municipal law or rule. Termination for "good cause" shall be effected by provision of a minimum of 30 days written notice to Client at the address noted herein.

Consultant will be entitled to full compensation, pursuant to the terms of this contract, through the termination date. Consultant will make all reasonable effort to provide for an orderly transfer of all records of the Client to the Client or its designee.

NON-PAYMENT:

The failure of Client to pay any amount due within 30 days of presentation shall constitute good cause for Consultant to suspend services provided under this Contract until full payment is received.

NON-CONTINGENCY:

The payment of fees and expenses, as outlined in this Contract, are not contingent upon any circumstance not specifically outlined in this Contract.

LEGAL COMPLIANCE:

Consultant shall, for as long as Consultant is under contract to provide the services described herein, be responsible:

- 1) To ensure that the Client website remains in compliance with all applicable Florida Statues regarding the content and functionality of such website.
- 2) To provide for the long-term storage of email in compliance with all applicable Florida Statues regarding records retention.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1) All invoices are due and payable upon presentation. For invoices not paid within 30 days of presentation, interest on the balance due will be charged at the maximum legally permissible rate.
- 2) In the event collection proceedings become necessary, Client agrees to pay all costs including attorney's fees.
- 3) Abandonment or suspension of the project shall not relieve the Client of monies due for services rendered to the date of such abandonment or suspension. Such services shall be billed at the applicable stated rates or full lump sum amounts and

will be immediately due and payable upon determination that the project has been abandoned or suspended and that the Consultant has performed the services as outlined herein.

- 4) Ownership of web site, content, domain name and e-mail addresses, under all circumstances is that of the Client.
- 5) The Client assumes full responsibility for damages awarded to third parties due to misuse by Client of the work product provided, in addition to any damages arising to the Consultant from said misuse by Client. Consultant shall have no responsibility for misuse by Client.
- 6) This Contract shall be interpreted in accordance with and shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida.
- 7) In the event that any provision of this contract shall be determined to be unenforceable or invalid by a Court of Law, such unenforceability or invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions of the Contract which shall remain in full force and effect.
- 8) The Client shall, to the extent allowable under applicable law and except and to the extent caused by negligence or willful misconduct of the Consultant, agree to indemnify, defend, and hold the Consultant harmless from and against any and all claims, actions, suits, demands, assessments or judgments asserted and any and all losses, liabilities, damages, costs, court costs, and expenses, including attorney's fees, alleged or that Consultant may hereafter incur, become responsible for, or be caused to pay out arising out of or relating to (1) damages caused to the Client by hacking or any other unauthorized access to the data or content on the Client web site or e-mail server; (2) damages caused by unauthorized use of Client's web site content or e-mail server by any third party; and (3) any claim for taxes or other charges which may be made against the Consultant which are the primary responsibility of the Client. The indemnification provided for herein shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which the Consultant may be entitled and shall continue after the Consultant has ceased to be engaged under this Agreement. Nothing herein shall be construed to limit Client's sovereign immunity provided in s. 768.28 F.S.

This Contract shall represent the entire agreement between the Consultant and the Client. Both Consultant and Client understand and agree with the terms and conditions as set forth herein.

Addendum "A"

Required Web Site Content

Pursuant to Chapter 189.069 F.S., district web sites will be required to include and make available the following information or documents:

- 1. The full legal name of the special district.
- 2. The public purpose of the special district.
- 3. The name, address, email address, and the term for each member of the governing body of the special district.
- 4. The fiscal year of the special district.
- 5. The full text of the special district's charter and the statute under which the special district operates, any grant of special powers, the date of establishment, and the establishing entity.
- 6. The mailing address, email address, telephone number, and internet website uniform resource locator of the special district.
- 7. A description of the boundaries and the services provided by the special district.
- 8. A listing of all taxes, fees, assessments, or charges imposed and collected by the special district, including the rates or amounts for the fiscal year and the statutory authority for the levy of the tax, fee, special assessment, or charge.
- 9. The primary contact person for the special district for purposes of communication from the Department of Economic Opportunities.
- 10. A code of ethics adopted by the special district, if applicable, and a hyperlink to generally applicable ethics provisions.
- 11. The adopted budget of the special district, in addition to budget amendments as required by with section 189.418, Florida Statutes.
- 12. The final, complete audit report for the most recent completed fiscal year and other audit reports required by law or authorized by the governing body of the special district.
