The second section is called Business Administration. The third section is called Business Items. The business items section contains items for approval by the District Board of Supervisors that may require discussion, motion and votes on an item-by-item basis. The fourth section is called Staff Reports. This section allows the District Manager, Engineer, and Attorney to update the Board of Supervisors on any pending issues that are being researched for Board action. Occasionally, certain items for decision within this section are required by Florida Statute to be held as a Public Hearing. During the Public Hearing portion of the agenda item, each member of the public will be permitted to provide one comment on the issue, prior to the Board of Supervisors' discussion, motion and vote. Agendas can be reviewed by contacting the Manager's office at (813) 933-5571 at least seven days in advance of the scheduled meeting. Requests to place items on the agenda must be submitted in writing with an explanation to the District Manager at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date of the meeting. The final section is called Supervisor Requests. This is the section in which the Supervisors may request Staff to prepare certain items in an effort to meet residential needs.

These sessions allow staff or consultants to discuss a policy or business matter in a more informal manner and allow for lengthy presentations prior to scheduling the item for approval. Typically no motions or votes are made during these sessions.

Call to Order

Mr. Roethke called the meeting to order and read roll call.

SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS

Audience Comments

There were no Audience members present.

THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of the Minutes of the Board of Supervisors' Regular Meeting held on August 26, 2014

On a Motion by Mr. Noble, seconded by Mr. Huey, with all in favor, the Board approved the Minutes from the Board of Supervisors' Regular Meeting held on August 26, 2014 as amended for Cordoba Ranch Community Development District.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of the Operation and Maintenance Expenditures for August 2014

Ms. Hudrlik commented on the current homeowner count on Envera's invoice. Mr. Roethke will follow up with Envera to ensure the number is correct.

On a Motion by Mr. Karpay, seconded by Mr. Huey, with all in favor, the Board approved the Operation and Maintenance Expenditures for August 2014 (\$22,230.19) for Cordoba Ranch Community Development District.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Proposals for New Fountain Installation

Mr. Roethke presented two proposals for fountain installation to the Board, as well as, two proposals for necessary electric upgrades at the fountain location. A discussion ensued regarding the details of each proposal. The Board requested that District staff confirm the extent of the electrical work involved, and that the scope of services on the fountain installation and electrical proposals do not overlap.

On a Motion by Mr. Noble, seconded by Mr. Karpay, with all in favor, the Board approved the Proposals from Aquagenix and Mandy Electric at a not to exceed amount of (\$25,500.00) for Cordoba Ranch Community Development District.

SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Pond Updates

Mr. Roethke presented a pond maintenance report to the Board which details the current status of each pond within the District. Mr. Roethke noted that the pond maintenance vendor has begun the cattail and dead woody material removals from the ponds last week. Discussion ensued regarding carp stocking in the ponds. The Board would like to see a proposal from Aquagenix for carp stocking at a future meeting. Mr. Roethke will provide this as soon as it is available.

SEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Landscape Update

Mr. Roethke updated the Board on any current landscaping issues within the District. Mr. Roethke is following up with ValleyCrest on the edging around the electrical boxes, the maintenance at pond 200, and some enhancement proposals to be provided. Ms. Hudrlik discussed the details of some of the proposals that ValleyCrest should be providing shortly. Mr. Karpay requested that ValleyCrest begin providing a checklist to the District that confirms all pond banks and common areas are being maintained on a regular basis. Mr. Roethke will follow up with ValleyCrest to ensure they begin providing this.

EIGHTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Proposals for Landscape Supervision Services

Mr. Roethke presented proposals for landscape supervision services from both OLM and Rizzetta Amenity Services. A discussion ensued. The Board requested Pete Williams' attendance at the next meeting to discuss the current scope of services and options for operations services. The Board took no action on the proposals at this time.

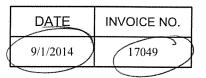

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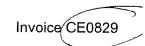

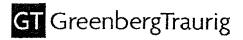

The following report is for September to illustrate what has changed from August and what to expect through October and the coming months.

We have reached out to the FWC for an appointment with a biologist on site to discuss the Triploid Grass Carp stocking. We don't have a date for that yet, however FWC has responded and we expect to set an appointment soon. The main thing we need to understand about your site is how many fish barriers would be required to complete the stocking. I will provide a full proposal for your consideration once we have all the information.

There was a slight delay in the fountain equipment shipping due to a back order on the LED lighting canisters. However, Aqua Control has confirmed the lighting sets are in and your entire order will ship from Illinois on Oct 22nd. With that in mind, we are anticipating installing both fountains likely in the first week of November. We will coordinate the installation with your electrician and notify Rizzetta when we have scheduled the date.

Overall, the algae issues for the most part have remained low.

Spike Rush continues to be enemy # 1 in the ponds and we are looking forward to lower water levels over the next few months when it will be exposed along the banks & easy to gain control.

The vegetation removal was completed and overall looks great! I did find however, a couple very minor spots that our crew must have overlooked and we will be returning to address that within the next 10-14 days. Those areas are noted in the report.

What we found: Water levels are still pretty high. Some torpedo grass growing up along the edges. Spike rush.

What we did: Application was applied to control spike rush.

What to expect: border grasses were not treated again this month to avoid damaging turf.



Recommendations & Notes: If we were to spray grasses right up to the current bank it would damage vegetation that helps prevent erosion. When levels lower, your maintenance company will be able to string trim down to the current waterline and we will treat more aggressively then, this helps minimize the "dirt bank" look.

Date: 10/9/14 Pond #110

What we found: The algae is for the most part under control at this time. Dying spike rush is seen floating in this picture.

What we did: Spike Rush and submersed vegetation were treated in Sept.

What to expect: New Fountains! Should be installed before the next report.



Notes: We are working hard on getting and keeping the submersed plants like spike rush & algae under control on ponds 100 & 110 to help keep the fountains running smooth.

Date: 10/09/14

What we found: Over all this pond

is looking good

What we did: Treated grasses and broad leaf weeds around the

perimeter.

What to expect: When we are on site for the fountain installation, I will make sure we put the boat in here also and treat that little spot grass out in the middle.

Pond #120



Recommendations & Notes: Landscape maintenance around this pond would help improve our access.

Date: 09/09/14

What we found: No more Cattails!

What we did: Cattails were

removed manualy.

What to expect: we expect to see some algae and issues following a big disturbance such was caused by the removal. We will be spraying to get this cleaned up.

Pond #125



Recommendations & Notes: The dead cattail stalks below the water decompose and can contribute to an algae bloom after removal. It is a normal part of the process.

Pond #126

What we found: Woops! The sticks in the bottom of this photo were supposed to be gone.

What we did: I have scheduled a follow up for one of the guys to get back and tidy up a couple spots.

What to expect: Overall the pond looks good!



Recommendations & Notes: There is a resident 3'-4'foot alligator in this pond. Just FYI...nothing to be concerned about in my opinion.

Date: 10/09/14

What we found: This pond has spatterdock(lilies), spike rush and is part of a long wet ditch.

What we did: The dead brush has been cut down along the ditch.

What to expect: Spike rush is still the main & only serious issue with this pond.

Pond #130



Recommendations & Notes: Lilies can help utilize excessive nutrients in the pond which can reduce algae blooms. If undesired at any time, just say the word and we can get rid of them.

What we found: This pond is looking much better overall. Still has some spike rush issues.

What we did: Grasses and spike rush were treated.

What to expect: Once we get the spike rush under control we should have most of the ponds looking very good.

Pond #140



Recommendations & Notes: We have improved many aspects of this pond and others on site, unfortunately, any gains are overshadowed by the severity of the spike rush outbreak. As we move forward and for years to come this will be our number one battle.

Date: 10/09/14

What we found: Spatterdock & something new, a submersed pond weed that has appeared. Some of what you see in bottom of photo is simple grass clippings from string trimming along the edge. No big deal.

What we did: we will treat to eliminate the new intrusion and leave the spatterdock.

What to expect: Let us know if you want the lilies treated or left in place.

Pond #143A



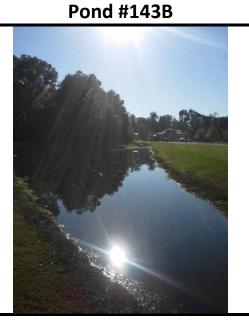

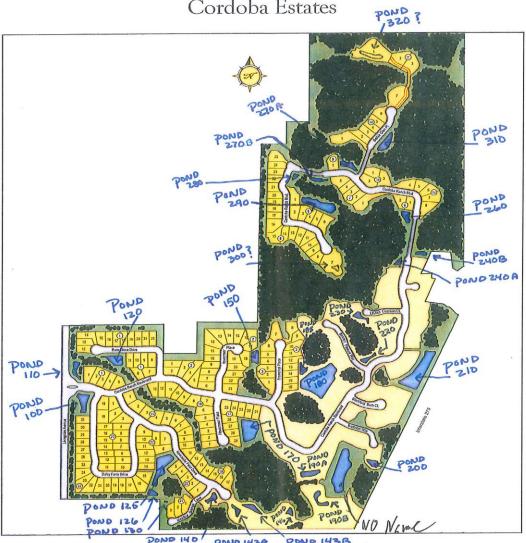
